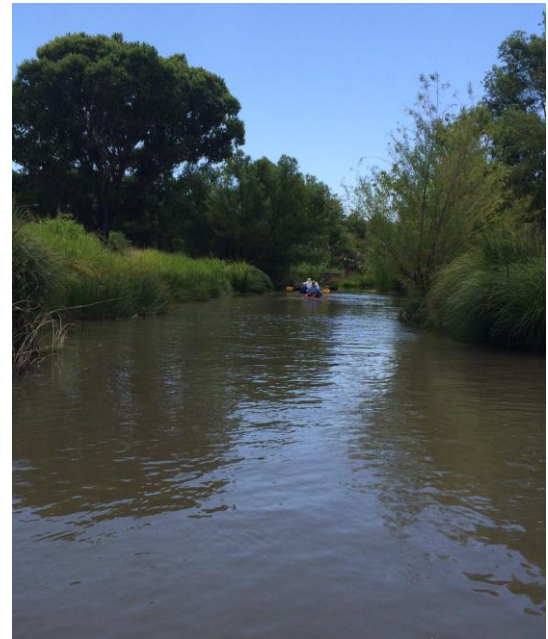

Floating the Verde River.... Summer 2017

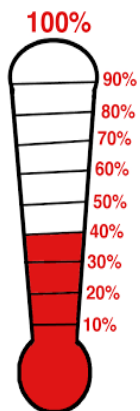

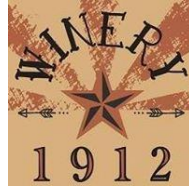
